Shepherds College is a fully accredited, post-secondary program for students with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities (IDD). Throughout the three-year program we will help equip you to reach Appropriate Independence through the development of vocational, social and life skills. We define Appropriate Independence™ as supported self-sufficiency, aligned with your individual strengths, and guided by Christian values. Started in 2008 and located in Union Grove, Wisconsin, Shepherds College has served students from 33 states and 8 foreign countries.

The Shepherds College campus offers a safe, supported and structured environment for students to develop socially, physically, and spiritually. Students develop life skills by transitioning through three phases of the Student Life program. The dorms provide the greatest degree of structure and support allowing students to successfully transition from home to campus. The halls and apartments present opportunities for increased levels of independence to prepare students for life after college.

Each year, students are invited to participate in athletics, clubs, regular off-campus outings, church and service projects. These activities help students develop leadership skills, make new friends, experience new things, and contribute to the community.
